Currently he is Director of Worship and the Arts, and Organist at First Presbyterian Church of Atlanta. He collaborates with Atlanta's major cultural centers such as the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra, High Museum and the Atlanta Opera to raise cultural awareness to the Greater Atlanta communities. He was a top honor graduate from the Conservatory National Supérieur de Musique in Paris, the Oberlin Conservatory as well as Musikhochschule in Bayreuth and McGill University in Montreal.

His talents reach beyond performer, as he is gifted in imaginative marketing, and in instituting highly creative - and successful - outreach efforts to develop and inspire today's audiences with exciting programs.
