(July 15 – August 10, 2024)

Application Process

To apply please submit the following:

1. A CD/MP3 file format showcasing your musical ability
 - * Duration 20 minutes total.
 - * First selection must be a work by Mozart; remainder of selections should include contrasting works.
 - * Label the CD/MP3 file with your name.
2. A typed program identifying your selections
 - * List the selections on program in the sequence of performance on your recording.
 - * Identify composer, followed by title of the selection.
 - * Include your name on the typed program.
3. A typed resume or curriculum vitae.
 - * Include current address, telephone and email.
4. Recommendations
 - * Two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, professors, or professional musicians.
 - * If available, include newspaper critiques or reviews.
5. Essay
 - * A short essay regarding your career goals and reasons for wanting to study at the Mozarteum.
6. Photo
 - * Glossy 8 x 10 or 5 x 7 inch Photograph or digital portrait for publicity purposes.
 - * Application materials become part of Pro-Mozart's permanent file.
7. Application Fee
 - * \$40.00 check or money order Payable to The Pro-Mozart Society of Atlanta, Inc., 270 Boca Ciega Ct., Johns Creek, GA 30022

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to compete for The Pro-Mozart Society Music Scholarship, applicants must be:

- * At least 18-99+ years of age at the time of the Competition Finals
- * **Either** a resident of Georgia
- * **Or** a student currently attending a Georgia college or university

Judges for the Pro-Mozart Society of Atlanta's 2024 Music Scholarship Competition will include professional musicians as well as music professors and instructors.

Accompanists

It will be the responsibility of each Finalist to secure the services of an accompanist if one is required for the Competition Finals.

 - Judges will evaluate recordings submitted by applicants, select finalists, and communicate decisions

 - Finalists present repertoire before judges and live audience
 - Judges announce winner
- * Music for the Competition Finals must be memorized
- * Original music scores must be provided to Judges at the Competition Finals
